COMPACT CAR TRAIN RACE

- 1. There will be three (3) cars chained together five feet (5') apart one person per car.
- 2. All cars must be compact, maximum 113" wheel-base on front wheel drive cars and maximum 106" wheel-base on rear wheel drive cars. No engine larger than 3.4 liter V-6. No V-8 or anything larger than 3.4 liter will be allowed.
- 3. **Front** car must have brakes made inoperable. You must removing brake master cylinder, brake pedal, or cut brake lines at the master cylinder. The front car has engine and steering only no brakes.

Middle car must have brakes AND engine made inoperable. You must remove brake master cylinder, brake pedal, or cut brake lines at the master cylinder. The engine can be removed or made inoperable by removing plug wires, distributor cap, or some other means of disabling engine. The middle car has steering only – no brakes or engine.

Rear car is to have brakes, but engine has been removed or made inoperable by removing plug wires, distributor cap, or some other means of disabling engine. The rear car has brakes and steering only – no engine.

- 4. All three cars must have DOT tires.
- 5. All glass, chrome and plastic to be removed, except the windshield is optional. Glass CANNOT be knocked down in door panel or inside the car. It MUST be removed.
- 6. Battery may be relocated.
- 7. All doors must be welded or chained shut.
- 8. All cars must have seat belts with shoulder belts recommended. Shoulder belts may be added if necessary.
- 9. Cars are to be chained together 5' apart. Chains cannot hook to bumpers, and no pipe is to be used on chains.
- 10. No racecars may be used as trains.....No roll bars.
- 11. All drivers must be at least 18 years old.
- 12. All drivers must wear approved helmet and eye protection, with drivers uniforms recommended.
- 13. All cars are subject to track approval prior to race.
- 14. Any cars coming unhooked from each other will be disqualified, black flagged and must stop or exit track.
- 15. Race will be 10 laps or one train left pulling, whichever comes first.
